OUR NURSERY IS NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, BUT IF YOU WOULD LIKE US TO BRING PLANTS FOR YOU, TO ANY OF THE EVENTS WE ARE ATTENDING FOR YOU TO VIEW AND COLLECT (WITHOUT OBLIGATION), PLEASE TELEPHONE, FAX, OR E-MAIL WITH YOUR REQUIREMENTS. ALTERNATIVELY, WE WILL BE HAPPY TO SEND THEM TO YOU IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO GET TO THE EVENTS. PLEASE PRINT OFF THE ORDER PAGE AND SEND IT TO US TOGETHER WITH YOUR CHEQUE. **CHEQUES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO P J & H E WELFORD**. PLANTS WILL NORMALLY BE SENT BY COURIER AND THE P&P CHARGES ON THE ORDER FORM ARE BASED ON THIS SERVICE FOR DELIVERY TO MAINLAND UK ADDRESSES IN ENGLAND, WALES AND PART OF SCOTLAND. THEREFORE IF PLANTS ARE TO BE DELIVERED TO SOME PARTS OF SCOTLAND, ISLANDS (EG. CHANNEL ISLES, SHETLAND ETC ) AND N.IRELAND, THERE MAYBE AN ADDITIONAL COST. PLEASE CONTACT US FOR DETAILS.

THIS LIST IS NOT AN EXHAUSTIVE LIST OF THE PLANTS WE PRODUCE OR HAVE IN STOCK, THEREFORE PLEASE ASK IF YOU CAN'T SEE WHAT YOU ARE LOOKING FOR. WE HAVE FOR SALE WILL CHANGE WITH THE SEASONS, SO THE LIST WILL CHANGE THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

DETAILS OF THE PLANTS PREFERRED SITE IS THE IDEAL, BUT NOT A MUST!!! PLANTS WILL ADAPT TO THE CONDITIONS IN THAT THEY ARE PLANTED. THEREFORE PROVIDING THE CONDITIONS YOU HAVE IN MIND FOR A PLANT, ARE NOT THE TOTAL OPPOSITE TO THE IDEAL, IT WILL ALMOST CERTAINLY GROW.

WE DO NOT CLAIM TO GROW OUR PLANTS IN A TOTALLY ORGANIC WAY, AS THE SOIL IN, WHICH THEY ARE POTTED, CONTAINS A SLOW RELEASE FERTILIZER. HOWEVER WE DO NOT USE ANY HERBISIDES OR PESTISIDES ON THEM. THEREFORE ANY NEW PET THAT YOU TAKE HOME WITH YOU WHEN YOU PURCHASE ONE OF OUR PLANTS COMES FREE OF CHARGE TO A GOOD HOME!.....

PBR – INDICATES A PLANT HAS PLANT BREEDERS RIGHTS AND CAN ONLY BE PROPAGATED UNDER LICENCE.

Ht – HEIGHT. Sp – SPREAD. THE HEIGHT AND SPREAD OF THE PLANTS LISTED, ARE JUST AN INDICATION OF ITS DIMENSIONS WHEN FULLY MATURE, IN FLOWER AND GROWING IN ITS IDEAL SITUATION. SO, SHOULD ONLY BE TAKEN AS A GUIDE.

*Agapanthus 'Blue Umbrella'* – Ht 90cm Sp 45cm. Clump forming perennial, with green strap like leaves and mid blue flowers in mid to late summer on a stiff stem. **1.5lt**

*Agapanthus 'Donau'* - Ht 90cm Sp 45cm. Clump forming perennial, with green strap like leaves and large pale blue flower heads with a central stripe during summer. **1.5lt**

*Agapanthus 'Thumbelina'* – Ht 20cm Sp 20cm. Unusual clump forming perennial. Dwarf growing habit with white flowers during summer **1lt**

*Agapanthus umbellatus albus* – Ht 80cm Sp 45cm. Clump forming perennial, with green strap like leaves and white flowers on a stiff stem during summer. **1lt/1.5lt**

*Alchemilla mollis* (AGM) – Ht 30cm Sp 75cm. Clump forming perennial. Pale green leaves, with many loose small cymes of green/yellow flowers in summer and autumn. **1lt**

*Anemone blanda* (AGM) – Ht 15cm Sp 15cm. Spreading tuberous perennial. Dark green three palmate leaves, producing lovely daisy style flowers 3-4cm across in deep blue, pink or white. **9cm**

*Anemone nemorosa* (Wood anemone)(AGM) – Ht 10-15cm Sp 30cm. Rhizomatic low growing perennial. In spring produces palmate green basal leaves and pinkish/white flowers. Prefers a semi-shaded site. **9cm**

*Anemone x hybrida 'Whirlwind'* – Ht 1.2m Sp 1.2m. Clump forming perennial with palmate mid green leaves. Semi-double white flowers with a slight twist to the petals in late summer/autumn. **1.5lt**

*Brodiaea laxa 'Queen Fabiola' syn. Tritelia laxa* – Cormous perennial with linear green leaves. In early summer it produces umbels of purple blue flowers. Prefers a sunny site. **9cm**

*Carex buchananii* – Ht 60cm Sp 60cm. Evergreen (brown!) perennial grass, with stiff tufted orange brown leaves. **1.5lt**

*Carex comans* ‘**Bronze**’ – Ht 30cm Sp 60cm. Evergreen (brown!) perennial grass, tussocks of hair like copper brown leaves. **1.5lt**

*Convallaria majalis* (Lily of the Valley)(AGM) – Ht 20cm Sp 30cm. Perennial with oval shaped dark green leaves. Scented bell shaped flowers during late spring. **CAUTION TOXIC IF EATEN 1lt**

*Cyclamen hederifolium* f. *albiflorum* (AGM) – Ht 10cm Sp 15cm. Hardy tuberous perennial with heart shaped patterned green leaves. In mid autumn produces pure white flowers before the leaves appear. **9cm**

*Dicentra spectabilis* ‘**Alba**’ (AGM) – Ht 60cm Sp 60cm. Clump forming perennial with finely cut leaves and heart shaped white flowers in late spring / early summer. **1.5lt**

*Dicentra spectabilis*(AGM) – Ht 60cm Sp 60cm. Clump forming perennial with finely cut leaves and heart shaped pink flowers in late spring / early summer. **1.5lt**

*Digitalis* ‘**Milk Chocolate**’ – Ht 90cm Sp 30cm. Evergreen perennial with dark olive green leaves. It produces flower spikes during summer with small milk chocolate coloured flowers. **CAUTION TOXIC IF EATEN 1.5lt**

*Echium russicum* – Ht 60cm Sp 30cm. Hairy leaves rosette forming perennial. Produces tall crimson red flower spikes throughout summer. **1lt**

*Elymus magellanicus* – Ht 25cm Sp 30cm. Rhizomatous spreading grass, clumps of intense steel blue, seeded heads in summer. **1.5lt**

*Endymion non scriptus* (English Bluebell) – Ht 30cm Sp 8cm. Clump forming bulbous perennial. Linear dark green leaves and in spring produces 6 to 12 bell shaped blue flowers per stem. **9cm**

*Epimedium grandiflorum* ‘**Lilafee**’ – Ht 25cm Sp 60cm. Clump forming, semi-evergreen rhizomatous perennial. The leaves are heart shaped, with the young leaves a copper/red colour turning green with age. Bears cup and saucer star shaped, lavender/violet flowers in late spring. **1lt/1.5lt**

*Epimedium x versicolor* ‘**Neosulphureum**’ – Ht 30cm Sp 90cm. Clump forming, semi-evergreen rhizomatous perennial. The leaves are heart shaped, with the young leaves a copper/red colour turning green with age. Bears cup and saucer star shaped, pale yellow flowers in late spring. **1.5lt**

*Eranthis hyemalis* (AGM) (Winter aconite) – Ht 8cm Sp 8cm. Clump forming tuberous perennial. Bright green leaves and yellow flowers in late winter/early spring. **9cm**

*Eryngium alpinum* (AGM) – Ht 70cm Sp 45cm. Tap-rooted perennial with heart shaped base leaves. In late summer produces blue cone shaped thistle like flower head with pinnatifid spiny bracts. **1.5lt**

*Eryngium planum* (Sea Holly) – Ht 90cm Sp 40cm. Clump forming semi-evergreen perennial. Dark green leaf, producing stems of spiky blue thistle flower heads in late summer. **1.5lt**

*Eryngium varifolium* – Ht 40cm Sp 30cm. Clump forming semi-evergreen perennial. Dark green leaves with white veins. In late summer has grey/blue thistle flower heads with spiky grey collar. **1lt**

*Euphorbia griffithii* ‘**Fireglow**’ – Ht 75cm Sp 75cm. Rhizomatous perennial with reddish green stems and dark green leaves. It has orange/red involucre. **1lt**

*Foeniculum vulgare* ‘**Puurpureum**’ syn ‘**Bronze**’ (Bronze Fennel) – Ht 1.5m Sp 45cm. Bronze /purple green foliage, which is finely cut almost hair like. It produces small yellow flowers in summer followed by seeds. Both the foliage and seeds have an aniseed flavour/smell and both can be used in cooking. **1lt / 1.5lt**

*Fritillaria meleagris* (Snakes head Fritillary) – Ht 25cm Sp 8cm. Bulbous perennial. Grey/green linear leaves. Produces bell shaped pink/purple checked, sometimes white flowers in spring. **9cm**

*Fritillaria uva-vulpis* – Ht 20cm Sp 5cm. Lance shaped dark green leaves producing normally solitary flowers. The flowers are bell shaped and purple brown in colour with a yellow rim. Prefer a well-drained site in full sun. **9cm**

*Galanthus nivalis* (Common Snowdrop)(AGM) – Ht 10cm Sp 10cm. Bulbous perennial with glaucous leaves and white flowers with a green marking on the edge of the inner tepal in winter. **1lt**

*Galanthus nivalis* ‘Flore Pleno’(AGM) – Ht 10cm Sp 10cm. Bulbous perennial with green narrow leaves. Irregular, double flowers in winter. **1lt**

*Gunnera manicata*(AGM) – Ht 2.5m Sp 3.5m. Very large clump forming perennial, with large rhubarb like, dark green leaves up to 2m in size. Prefers a moist site. **5lt**

*Hamamelis mollis* (Witch Hazel) – Ht 4m Sp 4m. Bushy deciduous shrub with oval shaped mid-green leaves, which turn yellow in autumn. Golden yellow spider shaped flowers appear on bare branches during mid-winter. **5lt**

*Helictrichon sempervirens pendula* (AGM) – Ht90cm Sp 75cm. Densely tufted semi evergreen grass. Blue/grey leaves which gracefully arch over and has stiff stems with airy pinnacles in summer. **1.5lt**

*Helleborus orientalis* – Ht 45cm Sp 45cm. Clump forming perennial with dark green leaves. During winter/early spring produces saucer shaped white/cream flowers which turn to pink/white with age. **1.5lt**

*Heuchera* ‘Cuppucino’ – Ht 40cm Sp40cm. Mound forming semi-evergreen perennial with wavy purple/maroon leaves. **1.5lt**

*Heuchera* ‘Plum Pudding’ (PBR) – Ht 50cm Sp 50cm. Mound forming semi-evergreen perennial. It has dark red/purple marbled ruffled leaves. It produces small maroon and green panicles of flowers in summer. **1.5lt**

*Heuchera micrantha*‘Palace Purple’ (AGM) – Ht 45cm Sp 45cm. Mound forming semi-evergreen perennial with metallic red/purple, shallow palmate leaves. It produces loose panicles of cream flowers during summer. **1.5lt**

*Hosta fortunei aureomarginata* (AGM) – Ht 75cm Sp 75cm. Clump forming perennial, oval shaped leaves with green centers and creamy yellow margins. Trumpet shaped violet flowers during summer. **1.5lt**

*Hosta ventricosa* (AGM) – Ht 50cm Sp 90cm. Clump forming perennial with broadly ovate heart shaped leaves. During summer produces tubular shaped purple flowers on tall flower stems. **1.5lt**

*Imperata cylindrica* ‘Rubra’ (Red Baron) – Ht 40cm Sp30cm. Slow spreading perennial grass. Leaves emerge in light green, which soon turn to a deep red. Prefers a moist well-drained soil in full sun. **1lt**

*Juncus effusus* ‘Spiralis’ – Ht 30cm Sp 45cm. Evergreen corkscrew rush. An interesting plant, producing a mass of spiraled curly green stems. **1.5lt**

*Lavendula angustifolia* ‘Hidcote’ (AGM) – Ht 60cm Sp 75cm. Bushy grey green aromatic leaved shrub. Producing dark purple flowers during summer. **9cm**

*Lavendula angustifolia*‘Munstead’ – Ht 45cm Sp 60cm. A more compact lavender than ‘Hidcote’ but with blue/purple flowers. **9cm**

*Leycesteria formosa* – Ht 2m Sp2m. Thicket forming deciduous shrub with bamboo canes. Ovate shaped dark green leaves and producing pendant like flowers with dark purple/red bract in summer and autumn. These flowers then turn to red/purple berries in autumn/winter. **1.5lt**

*Leymus arenarius* – Ht 150cm Sp 150cm. Rhizomatous spreading grass, clumps of blue/grey leaves. Produces stiff spike like seed heads during summer. **1.5lt**

*Liatris spicata* – Ht 100cm Sp 45cm. Tuberous perennial with lance shaped linear green leaves, decreasing in size as they go up the stem. Long lasting purple bottle brush like flower heads during late summer / early autumn. **1lt**

*Liatris spicata* ‘Alba’ – As *Liatris spicata*, but with white flowers. **1lt**

*Ligularia przewalskii* (AGM) – Ht 1.8m Sp 1m. Clump forming perennial with deeply toothed leaves. During summer it has tall dark stems with yellow flower spikes. **1lt**

*Limonium latifolium* (Sea Lavender) – Ht 60cm Sp 45cm. Olive green long spoon shaped leaves. Branched stems bear many small lavender/blue flowers in late summer. Prefers a sunny site in well drained soil. **1lt**

*Lobelia* ‘Compliment’ – Ht 100cm Sp 30cm. Clump forming perennial with mid-green leaves and tall red flower spike in mid summer. **1.5lt**

**Lobelia 'Queen Victoria'** (AGM) – Ht 90cm Sp 30cm. Clump forming perennial with deep purple stems and leaves. During summer it has tall scarlet flower spikes. **1.5lt**

**Lobelia 'Tanya'** – Ht 90cm Sp 30cm. clump forming perennial with deep green leaf flushed purple. During summer it produces spikes of flowers in vivid velvety purple. **1.5lt**

**Lupinus (Lupin Russell Variety)** – Ht 1m Sp 80cm. Clump forming perennial with palmate green leaves. It produces spikes of pea like flowers in a variety of colours. **9cm/1lt**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Cabaret'** – Ht 2m Sp 1.2m. Clump forming perennial grass with variegated cream and green leaves. **5lt**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Flamingo'** – Ht 2m Sp 1.2m . Perennial clump forming grass. Green leaves with central cream stripe. Large arching pale red plumes on a reddish stem. **1.5lt**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Kleine Fontane'** – Ht 1.5m Sp 1.2m. Perennial clump forming grass, which has fountainous airey seed heads, which are reddish at first turning to cream in autumn. **1.5lt**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Kleine Silberspinne'** – Ht 1.2m Sp 1.2m. Perennial clump forming grass, similar to *M. sinensis* 'Kleine Fontane', but the seed heads are not quite so fountainous and they turn more of a silvery white than cream. **1.5lt**

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Zebrinus'** (Zedbra Grass) – Ht 1.2m Sp 1.2m. Perennial clump forming grass with arching green leaves which have horizontal stripes of pale yellow. **1.5lt**

**Molinia caerulea 'Karl Foerster'** - Ht 1.5m Sp 1m. Perennial densely tufted grass with mid green leaves. Open Panicles of purple tinted spikelets in mid summer. **1.5lt**

**Molinia caerulea 'Variegata'** – Ht 45cm Sp 45cm. Perennial densely tufted grass with dark green and creamy yellow striped leaves. It produces ochre coloured stiff stem in summer with purple spikelets. **1.5lt**

**Morina longiflora** – Ht 90cm Sp 30cm. Semi-evergreen perennial, with dark green spikey thistle like leaves. Produces whorls of white flowers on tall stems, which turn pink/red when fertilized, during summer. **1lt**

**Ophiopogon planiscarpus 'Nigrescens'**(AGM) – Ht 20cm Sp 30cm. Often called the black grass, but it is actually a member of the convallariaceae family; the same family as lily of the valley). A rhizomatous, clump forming, evergreen (black!) perennial with arching strap shaped leaves. It has small white bell shaped flowers with a purple hue in summer, these in time will change to dark blue/black round berries. **1.5lt**

**Paeonia 'Sarah Bernhardt'**(Peony)(AGM) – Ht 90cm Sp 90cm. Herbaceous perennial with mid green leaves. Producing large double pink fragrant flowers. **1.5lt**

**Pennisetum alopecuriodes 'Hameln'** – Ht 90cm Sp 60cm. Clump forming, semi evergreen, densely tufted perennial grass. Narrow dark green leaves and white, with a purple tinge, fluffy, bottle-brush type seed heads in late summer/early autumn. **1.5lt**

**Penstemon 'Blackberry Ice'** – Ht 35cm Sp 35cm. Semi evergreen perennial. Produces dark purple tubular flowers though out summer. **1lt**

**Penstemon digitalis 'Husker's Red'** – Ht 75cm Sp 30cm. Clump forming semi-evergreen perennial. New leaves emerge dark red/maroon. Tall flower stalks with pink tinted white flowers throughout summer and into autumn. **1lt**

**Phormium tenax 'Purpureum'** – Ht 2.5m Sp 1.5m. Clump forming evergreen perennial with stiff purple sword shaped leaves. **3lt**

**Physocarpus opuliflorus 'Diablo'**(PBR) – Ht 3m Sp 3m. Deciduous shrub with dark purple green, palmate lobed leaves. It has small pink/white flowers during late spring. **2lt**

**Polystichum rigens** – Ht 40cm Sp 60cm. Evergreen fern with leathery shuttlecock green fronds. Prefers a shady site. **1.5lt**

**Primula beesiana** - Ht 60cm Sp 60cm. Rosette forming candelabra primula. During summer produces rosettes of rose coloured flowers with a yellow eye. **1lt**

**Primula bulleyana** (AGM) – Ht 60cm Sp 60cm. Rosette forming candelabra primula. During early summer produces rosettes of peach coloured flowers, which turn crimson/orange with age. **1lt**

***Primula denticulata*** (Drumstick primula)(AGM) – Ht 45cm Sp 45cm. Clump forming perennial primula, which produces balls of bell shaped flowers in spring and summer. They come in various shades from white to pink through to deep purple. **9cm**

***Primula japonica*** (AGM) – Ht 45cm Sp 45cm. Clump forming perennial candelabra primula, producing rosettes of red/purple flowers in late spring. **1lt**

***Primula vialii*** (AGM) – Ht 30cm Sp 30cm. Perennial primula with lance shaped, slightly hairy leaves. In early summer produces cones of crimson coloured buds on stiff stems. The flowers turn lilac in colour when the buds open. **9cm**

***Pulsitilla vulgaris*** (AGM) – Ht 10-20cm Sp 20cm. Clump forming perennial, with fern like light green leaves. In spring produces bell shaped flowers in shades from pale to deep purple on finely haired stems. **9cm**

***Rumex sanguineus*** (Bloody Dock) – Ht 90cm Sp 30cm. A tap rooted perennial, its leaves are green red/purple veins. **1lt**

***Sambucus nigra* ‘Black Lace’**(AGM/PBR) - Ht 3m Sp 3m. A bushy deciduous shrub, of the elder family with deeply cut dark, almost black leaves. It has flat panicles of pink flowers during late spring/early summer. **1.5lt / 5lt**

***Sambucus racemosa* ‘Sutherlands Gold’** (AGM/PBR) – Ht 3m Sp 3m. Deciduous bushy shrub, with finely cut leaves, start bronze turning to golden yellow. Producing panicles of creamy coloured flowers in spring, followed by red berries in late summer. **1.5lt / 5lt**

***Sarcococca confusa*** (AGM) – Ht 2m Sp 1m. Bushy, round evergreen shrub with glossy dark green leaves. Producing small white highly scented flowers in winter, followed by shiny black berries. **1.5lt**

***Scabiosa* ‘Chille Black’** – Ht 60cm Sp 60cm. Clump forming perennial, with compact growing habit. Deep purple/black pincushion flowers during summer and autumn. **1lt**

***Scabiosa caucasica*** – Ht 60cm Sp 60cm. Clump forming perennial with grey/green leaves. Producing varying shades of blue coloured flowers on long stems during summer. **1lt**

***Scabiosa caucasica* ‘Alba’** – Ht 60cm Sp 60cm. As per *S. caucasica*, but with white flowers. **1lt**

***Scirpoides holoschoenus* ‘Variegatus’** – Ht 90cm Sp 60cm. Unusual semi-evergreen stemmed rush. The stem is horizontally striped green and creamy white. Prefers a moist site. **1lt**

***Sempervivium* ‘Standard Green’** – Ht 5cm Sp 15cm. Bright green succulent alpine with evergreen rosettes. **9cm**

***Sempervivium calcareum*** – Ht 5cm Sp 15cm. This alpine has bright green, evergreen rosettes tipped with deep red. **9cm**

***Stipa gigantea***(AGM) – Ht 2.5m Sp 1.2m. Semi-evergreen perennial grass, with thin arching leaves. Producing long stems with oat like seed heads in late spring, which turn golden during summer. **1.5lt**

***Stipa gigantea*** (AGM) – Ht 2.5m Sp 1.2m. Semi-evergreen perennial grass, with thin arching leaves. Producing long stems with oat like seed heads in late spring, which turn golden during summer. **1lt/1.5lt**

***Thymus* ‘Doone Valley’** – Ht 10cm Sp 35cm. Mat forming semi evergreen perennial thyme, with tiny green and golden aromatic leaves. It produces lavender pink flowers during summer. **7cm**

***Tricyrtis*** – *Tricyrtis* are rhizomatous, herbaceous perennials mainly coming from the E. Hymalayas to the Philippines and are fully hardy. They are commonly known as Toad Lilies. In the main prefer a moist, humus rich, well drained soil in partial shade, but are relatively easy to grow establishing clumps of 30cm to 60cm across. Most produce star shaped orchid like flowers, but some produce funnel or bell shaped flowers, however all flowers have 6 petals. They mainly produce their flowers in late summer and through out autumn. *Tricyrtis* are a bit of a passion of ours, we are trying to build up our stock and collection of *Tricyrtis*, (currently have 42 different varieties) so some of these listed may only be available in low numbers. If there is a particular variety that you are looking for, but not listed below, please contact us we maybe able to help.

***Tricyrtis* ‘Adbane’** – Ht 90cm. Large leaves faintly spotted, white star shaped flowers with light purple spots, the widest 3 petals are shaded a darker purple towards the tips. Flowers during September/October. **1.5lt**

*Tricyrtis* ‘**Harlequin**’ – Ht 60cm. Lightly spotted green leaves. Star shaped pink/pale lilac flowers, lightly spotted flowers. Flowers September/October. **1.5lt**

*Tricyrtis* ‘**Imperial Banner**’ (PBR) – Ht 80cm Sp 60cm. Clump forming perennial with green and cream striped leaves. It produces star shaped orchid like white flowers with lilac spots. Terra Nova nurseries in America developed this plant in 2006. **As far as we are aware, we are one of the few if not the only nursery in the country that currently has this plant for sale! 9cm/1.5lt**

*Tricyrtis* ‘**Lighting Strike**’ (PBR) – Ht 90cm. Green leaves which are streaked yellow and cream. White star shaped flowers spotted dark maroon. Flowers August/September. **1.5lt**

*Tricyrtis* ‘**Tojen**’ – Ht 50cm. Very large dark green leaves relative to the flowers. The star shaped flowers are a creamy white, with the three widest petal edged with blue/lavender. The filaments, style and stigma are spotted lavender. It flowers from August to October. **1.5lt**

*Tricyrtis fomesana* ‘**Gilty Pleasure**’ (PBR) – Ht 60cm Sp 30cm. Electric yellow foliage in spring which remains a good golden colour though out the season. In autumn produces orchid like star shaped white flushed pink purple flowers with purple spots. Prefers a partially shaded site. Terra Nova nurseries in America recently bred this toad lily. **9cm/1lt/1.5lt**

*Tricyrtis formosana* (AGM) – Ht 90cm. Green leaves. Pale pink/white star shaped flowers with lavender spots. Flowers during September/October. **1.5lt**

*Tricyrtis hirta* – Ht 60cm. – Mid-green slightly hairy leaves and stem. Star shaped white flowers with lilac coloured spots. Flowers late August to October. **1.5lt**

*Tricyrtis latifolia* – Ht 90cm. Mid-green leaves. Star shaped yellow flowers with chocolate coloured spots. One of the earlier flowering *tricyrtis*, flowering from late July into September. **1.5lt**

*Uncinia rubra* – Ht 25cm Sp 30cm. Evergreen, tufted grass with deep red/brown leaves. **1.5lt**

*Vitis* ‘**Brant**’ (AGM) – Ht/Sp 7m. Deciduous green leaved grape vine, whose leaves turn a coppery red in autumn. Produces bunches of edible black grapes. **2lt**

*Weigela florida* ‘**Purpurea**’ (AGM) – Ht 1m Sp 1.5m. Deciduous, purple/green leaved shrub, which produces dark pink funnel shaped flowers in late spring/early summer. **1.5lt**
