CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. The competition shall be open to senior amateur golfers who are members of recognised golf clubs and are aged 50 and over on 31st July 2007.
2. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the special rules for stroke-play competitions as approved by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and in accordance with the Local Rules.
3. The names and addresses of competitors, along with the entry fee, should be lodged with the Match Secretary, Burntisland Golf House Club, Dodhead, Burntisland, Fife by 22nd July 2007. Entrants must indicate their playing handicaps as certified by the secretary of their home club.
4. Scratch and handicap prizes will be awarded in two sections — Scratch-16 and 16+. Ladies and Gents playing handicaps will apply and the combined handicaps must not exceed 54 (Gents 24 max, Ladies 36 max).
5. The competitors with the lowest **Scratch** score will receive the Haldane Trophy. The competitors with the lowest **Nett** score will receive the Rosewall Trophy.
6. One round of the course - stroke-play will be played. The draw shall be arranged from 10 am. Competitors should state their preferred starting time and every effort will be made to accommodate them.
7. Ladies will commence play from the first tee.
8. In the event of a tie for The Haldane or Rosewall Trophies, the winner will be the competitor having the better inward half. If still tied, the better score over the last 6 holes, 3 holes will decide. As in all other ties, prize vouchers will be shared equally.
9. No competitors will be eligible to win more than one prize. In the event of competitors qualifying for a prize in both Handicap and Scratch sections, they will be awarded the prize which has the higher value.
10. The Haldane and Rosewall Trophies will remain the property of Burntisland Golf House Club.
11. The Committee of Burntisland Golf House Club reserves the right to reject any entry, to alter or amend any of the foregoing conditions and to decide any dispute which may arise in connection with the competition.
