We have named the garden "Viridis" which is Latin for green.

The garden is a modern interpretation of the cottage garden, but with a twist, while retaining its beauty, but cutting down on its maintenance.

Planted mainly with Hardy perennials, while looking good they are very robust and will more or less look after themselves.

The lawn has been replaced by stone paving and shingle, so saving time on cutting the grass, and giving you the space to relax and enjoy the garden.

Although there is no lawn, the garden is still lush and green, with the living wall of clover which does not need cutting.

Some of the plants used in the garden are:
Agapanthus 'Headbourne Hybrids', *Agapanthus umbellatus* alba,
Clerodendrum bungei "Pink Diamond", *Dahlia* "Candy Eyes",
Eryngium varifolium, *Foeniculum vulgare* "Purpureum" (Bronze Fennel), *Geranium* "Pink Spice",
Heuchera "Green Spice", *Stipa gigantea*, *Verbena bonariensis*.

Thistlefield Plants and Design began life in 2002, born out of a passion for plants. The business was established in a field in West Norfolk, which was overrun with weeds and thistles, hence our name.

We are a small family run nursery growing a range of plants, mainly perennials, from the everyday varieties to the more unusual.

We care about wildlife and the environment, therefore no herbicides or pesticides are used on any of our plants.

Any waste products, produced on the nursery or from landscaping, where possible are reused, recycled or composted.

Although our nursery is not open to the public, our plants can be purchased from us at events

throughout Norfolk, local farmers markets and from farm
