9. Informant for death of Thomas Charles WAKERLEY in Sydney in 1884. His relationship was stated to be a cousin. The deceased was a son of William WAKERLEY & Ann, née WHITEHOUSE. Ann was c. 15 Dec 1836 B St Mtn, son of Thomas WHITEHOUSE (Brazier) & Elizabeth. The cousinship is unclear. See Tree 478.

10. Per correspondent 182, m. & stayed in USA.

11. The tree of correspondent 182 has "Godavari" written beneath "RAWSON", "E Charles ADAMS" & also beneath Percy Charles WHITEHOUSE's 1881 birth date. It is unclear whether the first two annotations refer to the marriage or to the husband, presumably the latter, since Eva Kate WHITEHOUSE m. RAWSON in Birmingham. It is believed that the reference is to Godavari, a district in India.

12. Allegedly married a bigamist.

13. Indexed by GRO as Ada W PITTAWAY.

14. Perhaps John WHITEHOUSE was c. 24 Apr 1752 AS St P & P to Isaac & Ann, as part of a family c. 1747 to 1766 AS St P & P.

15. Per corresp. 182, Samuel's regt. and date were recorded in a small family bible. He enlisted 23 Aug 1816 in the 15th Hussars and was initially stationed at Nottingham, but spent much of his time in Loughrea Co. Galway, Ireland, but died after 2 days in regimental hospital. According to corresp. 182, all his records were destroyed.

16. Isaac d. from "shuma diarrhoea" (per death cert.) at 53 Sheward St

17. Charles d. from "disease of mesenteric glands" (per death cert.) at 52 Sheward St, 7 days after his father, Isaac.
